FLORIDA BUSINESSES STRENGTHEN OUR STATE

Housing and Economic Recovery Act of 2008 (HERA)

- Includes \$541 million total allocation to Florida for Neighborhood Stabilization Program
- \$450 million in direct funding from the Federal Department of Housing and Urban Development to 48 "entitlement" communities
- \$91 million to state government, of which \$88 million will go to local governments



Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP)

On July 30, 2008, former President Bush signed into law the Housing and Economic Recovery Act of 2008 to address the severe housing crisis. Title III of the Act appropriates \$3.92 billion of grant funds under the Neighborhood Stabilization Program for states and local governments



to purchase and redevelop abandoned or foreclosed properties. It also directed the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development to target funding to areas with the greatest needs based on the extent of foreclosures,

subprime mortgages, and mortgage delinquencies and defaults. The Federal Notice, which was released on September 30, provides information regarding method of allocation, program requirements, application procedures, and waivers granted.

- A total of \$88 million will be allocated to the areas of greatest need in the State of Florida.
- Two separate Neighborhood Stabilization Program allocations: the Regular Neighborhood Stabilization Program Allocation and the Supplemental Low-Income Allocation for rental housing.
