Overview

 NRC regulations and security orders establish requirements for the protection of spent nuclear fuel (SNF) in transport

- Security requirements provide high assurance of adequate protection of -
 - Public health and safety
 - Common defense and security
 - Environment



Transport Rulemaking

- SNF transportation security rulemaking is intended to address -
 - Generic applicability of post 9/11/2001 orders
 - Lessons learned from previous NRC inspections
 - Issues raised in petition for rulemaking from the State of Nevada (PRM-73-10)
- SNF transportation security rulemaking is separate from SNF storage facility security rulemaking



Rulemaking (cont.)

- Rulemaking midway through process
 - Proposed rule with Commission
- Next step
 - Publish proposed rule for comment
 - Publish supporting guidance documents for comment
 - Projected publication before end of 2010



Rulemaking (cont.)

- Major Elements of rulemaking
 - Advance planning and coordination with States
 - Increased notifications and communication
 - Continuous and active shipment monitoring
 - Armed escorts over entire shipment
 - Background investigations (access to Safeguards Information)



Rulemaking (cont.)

- Training and qualification
- Separate future rulemaking to apply 42 U.S.C. § 2201a to SNF transportation
 - Enhanced weapons (machine guns) and preemption of State requirements
 - Firearms background checks on armed escorts
 - Discussions needed with DOJ on impacts of 18 U.S.C. § 922(q) restrictions to SNF shipment security



Summary

 The rulemaking on SNF transportation security is at a midpoint

 The rulemaking on enhanced weapons for SNF transport is several years away



Conclusion

SNF has been shipped safely and securely for decades

 SNF shipments are occurring today both domestically and internationally

 NRC's ongoing and future rulemakings will enhance security of SNF transportation
