Off-site emergency plan

- To insure efficient usage of resources
- Minimize the impact on people and the environment in the event of an accident.
- State the rescue organization and point out lead directions.



CABs rescue service responsibilities


- To have an emergency plan in case of an incident at a NPP
- Decide who is to be the overall incident commander
- Organize and man a main command center
- Organize decontamination



CAB decides about

- Warning
- Public information
- Measures to protect people, animals and environment
- Monitoring of radioactivity
- Decontamination





In counties with NPP:



- Alarm
- Distribution of iodium tabs
- Evacuation
- Co-ordination of information



Duty officer with decision-making responsibilities

- 24 hours a day for one week
- Answer within 10 min.
- Open the main command center within 1h






