The First Responders role from preparation to mitigation:

The mission of the fire department is to isolate, contain, and stabilize incidents that put the public/property/environment at risk during an emergency.





Fire Department responsibilities have expanded throughout the decades













These responsibilities have fallen onto many fire departments capable hands





Preparation

- Identification of at risk populations and infrastructure by proposed transportation routes.
- Plan for worst case scenarios if risk can not be rerouted, reduced, or eliminated.
- Develop Incident Action Plans for material transport.
- Train with city, county, state, and federal agencies;
 Identify, Isolate, Notify, Mitigate, and Terminate.





Mitigation

- Using current technology and best practices:
- TDS (Time, Distance, Shielding)
- Alara (As Low As Reasonably Achievable)
- Department SOP voluntary to 150R





Termination

- All agencies participate (DOE, doe, IDPH, OEM, etc)
- Lessons Learned (after action/debrief/critique)
- Change SOPs
- Train, Train, Train
