**Introduction and Purpose of Meeting:** The Invasive Species Advisory Committee (ISAC) – comprised of thirty nonfederal invasive species experts and stakeholders from across the nation – will meet in Denver, CO, June 14-16, 2011 to develop recommendations and advice to the Secretary of the Interior and other members of the National Invasive Species Council. The meeting will focus on adapting management of invasive species in the vast Rocky Mountain / High Plains region as we gain new understandings of landscape ecology, climate change, land development, introduction pathways, and new invaders. ISAC will meet in Denver to consult with Western-based scientists and practitioners on problems and potential solutions and evaluate the on-the-ground issues firsthand, thereby determining how management methods and practices can be adapted in the West to prevent and manage invasive species.
