Assistant Special Agent-in Charge (ASAC) Randall Kizer has served in law enforcement since 1985. He began his law enforcement career as an Auxiliary Police Officer with the Sweetwater, Tennessee Police Department serving as a communication officer as well as a Patrol Officer. He served as a Criminal Investigator for the Tennessee 10th Judicial District, District Attorney Generals' Office from 1988 through 1992. During his tenure with the District Attorney General ASAC Kizer was assigned to homicide investigations and other major crimes to include narcotics, robbery, and child abuse investigations.

He joined the Department of Energy, Office of Inspector General (OIG) in July 1993 after a short term as a criminal investigator with the Tennessee Valley Authority, OIG. Since that time he has served as a Senior Special Agent in the Oak Ridge Investigations Office. Notably, he was instrumental in initiating the East Tennessee Environmental Crimes Task Force, which has been recognized throughout the United States as a model for law enforcement teaming. As a Special Agent and ASAC he has been directly involved in cases that have resulted in 42 criminal convictions and the recovery of approximately \$100 million. He holds a Bachelor of Science degree from East Tennessee State University.
