Tammy Anzenberger is a Law Enforcement Liaison Specialist with the Financial Crimes Enforcement Network (FinCEN). She is responsible for training and inspecting federal agencies with access to FinCEN's Currency and Banking retrieval system. She has 26 years of law enforcement experience.

Ms. Anzenberger was formerly a counterintelligence officer at the Missile Defense Agency, where she provided direct support to missile tests. She previously served as a Senior Special Agent with HUD OIG, Special Investigations Division and at the Transportation Security Administration.
