Facilitators Needed for FY12 Programs

The Inspector General Criminal Investigator Academy (IGCIA) utilizes experienced criminal investigators from the federal Inspector General (IG) community to act as facilitators during our IG Investigator Training Program (IGITP), Basic Non-Criminal Investigator Training Program (BNCITP), Undercover Investigations Training Program (UCITP), and Advanced Interviewing for IG Investigators (AIIGI). Facilitators augment the IGCIA staff by mentoring and assisting the students in an interactive training environment. This experience has proven to be beneficial to the students, the facilitator, and the IGCIA staff; and provides an excellent developmental opportunity for participating agents. **The IGCIA covers all facilitator travel costs.**

Facilitators should have 10 or more years of criminal investigator experience and at least five years in an OIG. Graduation from the Criminal Investigator Training Program (or equivalent) and either the IGITP or the IG Transitional Training Program are prerequisites. Additional requirements apply for facilitators supporting particular programs as follows:

- IGITP & BNCITP: Strong leadership, interviewing, and report writing skills;
- UCITP: Extensive experience working in an undercover capacity;
- AIIGI: Strong interviewing skills and techniques, including familiarization with rapport, theme development, and evidence presentations.
