ATF ANNOUNCES \$5,000 REWARD FOR GUN THEFT

ST. PAUL, Minn. — Special Agent in Charge Bernard J. More than 30 handguns were stolen during a burglary of the federally licensed firearms dealer on July 12, 2012.
