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# **NTSB's Mission**

NTSB is an independent federal agency, charged by Congress to investigate transportation accidents, determine probable cause, and issue safety recommendations.



#### Other NTSB Responsibilities:

 Acts as U.S. accredited representative to foreign aviation accidents under the provisions of the International Civil Aviation Authority (ICAO) agreements.

#### Other NTSB Responsibilities:

- Provides family assistance following accidents.
- Evaluates the effectiveness of emergency responses to hazardous materials accidents.

#### Independence


The NTSB reports directly to Congress.






Since its inception in 1967, NTSB has issued 12,769 Safety Recommendations:


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
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
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# **Light Bulb Analysis**

# **Light Bulb Filaments**








Was this light illuminated or extinguished at impact?




