SCRIPT FOR ONE STUDENT

Hey guys, [INSERT NAME] here.

I'm so pumped. I just turned 18. Man, it sure is awesome being a legal adult. Plus, I'm really looking forward to graduating and going to college. Good thing that I remembered to register with Selective Service so I was able to take out a student loan.

Federal law says guys our age have to register with Selective Service within a month of our 18th birthday. Registering also keeps us eligible for lots of good jobs, driver's license renewal in most states, and job training. Plus, if you're an immigrant and you're a guy, you can never get citizenship if you don't register.

It's the law, guys. Not to mention, it's real easy to register. Go to the post office or go online to www.sss.gov. It only takes a few minutes and if you forget to do it, you could miss out on a lot of awesome opportunities. So make sure to register.

SCRIPT FOR PRINCIPAL OR OTHER ADMINISTRATOR



Good morning. Are you a 17- or 18-year-old guy?

Do you want to keep your driver’s license, be eligible for college loans, job training, government jobs, and citizenship if you’re an immigrant?

Then make sure you register with Selective Service within a month of your 18th birthday.

Federal law says you must register. If you don’t, you miss out on all of these opportunities and more.

Don’t let that happen to you! It’s quick and easy to register. It only takes a few minutes to register online at www.sss.gov. Or, you can register at the post office.

SCRIPT FOR TWO STUDENTS



Student One: Hey man, happy birthday! How does it feel to finally be 18?

Student Two: It's awesome. But since I'm a man now, I really shouldn't be hanging out with guys like you.

Student One: Haha, shut up dude. Let's go out and celebrate.

Student Two: Definitely, but first I've got to get online at sss.gov and register with Selective Service.

Student One: What's that?

Student Two: Federal law says all men living in the United States have to register with Selective Service within a month of their 18th birthday. Registering keeps me eligible for a driver's license in most states. Plus, if I don't register, I can't get college loans, job training, or a lot of good jobs. Know what else? If you're a male immigrant, you can't ever become a citizen if you don't register. It's a really big deal.

Student One: Wow. I had no idea that it was a law. If I don't register, I miss out on all that stuff?

Student Two: That's right. Good thing you've got an older, wiser friend to let you know what's up. Just remember, when you turn 18, make sure you go online at sss.gov and take care of it. Or you can always fill out a registration card at the post office. Now, what time are you taking me out to celebrate?
