1 This matter is before the Court on the parties' joint motion to approve the
2 parties' Settlement Agreement pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 23(e).
3

4 The Court preliminarily approved the Settlement Agreement by Order of
5 October 26, 2010. The parties timely disseminated notice of the proposed
6 Settlement to the Class in accordance with the Preliminary Approval Order, and no
7 class member has objected to the Court's approving the Settlement.
8

9 The Court finds that:
10

- 11 1. The Settlement Agreement is fair, reasonable, and adequate to the
12 Class Members;
- 13 2. The Settlement Agreement has been negotiated at arm's length
14 between competent, able counsel, and no collusion existed in connection
15 with the Settlement Agreement;
16
- 17 3. The record is sufficiently developed and complete to have enabled
18 Plaintiffs and Defendants to evaluate and consider their positions.
19

20 **ACCORDINGLY, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**
21

- 22 1. That the Settlement be and is hereby approved pursuant to Federal
23 Rule of Civil Procedure 23(e);
24
- 25 2. That the Court's Injunction entered January 8, 2008, is dissolved;

1 3. That the Settlement Agreement shall be implemented in accordance
2 with its terms;

4 4. That this Action and all claims asserted therein are hereby dismissed
5 with prejudice; AND

6
7 5. The Court shall retain jurisdiction over this matter as provided in
8 Sections IX and XI of the Settlement Agreement.

9
10 There being no just reason for delay, this Order shall be deemed final and the Clerk
11 of the Court is directed to enter this Order forthwith.
