Question: Does VA permit fliers, advertisements, or other recruitment materials for non-VA research

to be posted on VA premises?

Answer: No. VA does not permit recruitment fliers or advertisements for non-VA research to be

posted within or on the premises of a VA facility. The word "posting" includes

announcing, distributing, publishing, or advertising the study either electronically or by hard copy to anyone, including Veterans, clinicians, or other staff. Therefore, ads, fliers, or other recruitment materials for non-VA research cannot be distributed, posted, or laid out in clinic waiting rooms; posters for non-VA research cannot be placed on VA bulletin boards; and recruitment materials for non-VA research cannot be provided on VA

websites or included in VA e-mails.
