  - Made updates to most sections (Access Control, Software Installation, etc.)
  - Redrafted epollbook and externally network connectivity requirements
  - Made updates to OEVT and IVVR-related requirements

### Coordination with TGDC

- NIST-TGDC work coordination
  - 46 telecons since last May 21-22 TGDC meeting
  - Revisions and updates to much draft material
  - Numerous individual discussions
- VVSG August 7 draft build
  - 1170 requirements, 570 pages, new format for improved readability
  - The VVSG is complete:
    - NIST will improve introductory material
    - Final technical editing and formatting will require 2-3 weeks
