## FEDERAL TRAVEL REGULATION GSA Bulletin FTR 11-05

TO: Heads of Federal Agencies

SUBJECT: Relocation Allowances—Relocation Income Tax (RIT) Allowance

- 1. What is the purpose of this bulletin? This bulletin informs agencies of the annual changes to the RIT allowance tables necessary for calculating the amount of a transferee's increased tax burden due to an employee's official permanent change of station. The RIT allowance tables are available on the GSA Web site at <a href="https://www.gsa.gov/relocationpolicy">www.gsa.gov/relocationpolicy</a>.
- 2. What is the background of this bulletin? GSA published FTR Amendment 2008-04, June 25, 2008, in the Federal Register (73 FR 35952) announcing that the RIT allowance tables previously available in FTR part 302-17, Appendices A through D, would be moved to a GSA web site. The amendment specified that GSA would publish a bulletin announcing when the annual changes are available for agency use.
