3. Register for a specific session by entering the appropriate Course Code into the keyword search. Refer to the table at the top of this page for course numbers



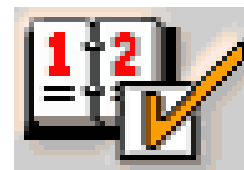

2) Keyword Search
Enter a keyword or course number.

For example: **WC1961**

4. Select the type of credit you wish to receive (Available credit types include CME, CNE, CHEC, CEU, CPE, or AUDIT for a certificate of attendance) and click Submit to complete your registration.
5. Complete the evaluation online. (You must complete this process by the credit expiration date)
