- Connect the Features: Create a poster or brochure about two of the animals you discussed in class. Describe and illustrate features that both have in common and connect those two features with a colored piece of yarn or a colored line. Then describe and illustrate features that are different between the two animals and connect them with a different-colored line or piece of yarn.
- **Short Story:** Pick one feature (fur, feathers, long ears, 4 legs, etc.) and write a short story about what it would be like if you had that feature. What could you do if you had that feature?
