LionShare Overview

- Secure P2P network based on digital identity and institutional trust fabric
- Integrated with access to digital repositories of learning objects around the world
- Two-year project sponsored by the Andrew W. Mellon Foundation



LionShare Goals

- Develop a secure P2P network that supports responsible file sharing
- Exploit the power of P2P architecture for academic collaboration
- Support the discovery and reuse of educational content
- Simplify the metadata creation process for users



LionShare Capabilities

- Publish share files with or w/out access control privileges
- Search find resources on LionShare P2P and repository networks
- Organize help users organize their own content whether shared or not



LionShare Capabilities

- Collaborate enable collaboration around resources and among individuals
- Security users control access to shared resources
- Persistence the PeerServer enables sharing even when users are not connected



LionShare Benefits

- No anonymous users responsible file sharing
- Federated searching of multiple learning resources
- Multi-institutional participation
- More efficient use of network resources
- Open Source development
- Platform extensible for future development



LionShare Risks

- Infrastructure required for trust fabric may be too complicated for some institutions
- Copyright may be inadvertently infringed by users who don't understand copyright
- Monitoring of network use may inhibit some users from trying the LionShare network

LionShare Risks

- Less restrictive technologies may be adopted rather than LionShare
- Misconceptions about LionShare capabilities may lead some to reject participation
- Security architectures (e.g., firewalls) may inhibit any type of file sharing, including LionShare

- LionShare v0.8 Beta April 31, 2005
- LionShare v1.0 Public September 31, 2005
