ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION OF NON-PARTY U.S. PIPE & FOUNDRY COMPANY, INC. FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On March 5, 2012, non-party U.S. Pipe & Foundry Company, Inc. ("U.S. Pipe") filed an unopposed motion to extend the time for U.S. Pipe to file a motion to quash or limit a Subpoena *Duces Tecum* (the "Subpoena") served on it on or about February 24, 2012 by Respondent McWane, Inc. ("McWane"), with a response date of March 21, 2012. U.S. Pipe states that pursuant to the Federal Trade Commission Rules of Practice, 16 C.F.R. § 3.34(c), the deadline to file a Motion to Limit or Quash McWane's Subpoena is March 7, 2012. U.S. Pipe seeks an order extending its deadline to March 23, 2012 and requests its response to the Subpoena be tolled during that period.

In support of its motion, U.S. Pipe states that the parties are engaged in negotiations regarding the scope of the Subpoena, its objections, and the time required for U.S. Pipe to produce its documents. U.S. Pipe further states that Respondent McWane does not oppose an extension through March 23, 2012 in order to afford U.S. Pipe's counsel sufficient time to continue negotiating with McWane's counsel on reasonable limitations and modifications of McWane's specifications to reduce the burden on U.S. Pipe of responding, thereby potentially avoiding the necessity of filing a motion to quash or limit the Subpoena.

Accordingly, based on the foregoing, the Unopposed Motion is GRANTED. It is hereby ORDERED that the deadline for non-party U.S. Pipe to file any motion to limit or quash the Subpoena shall be March 23, 2012. During that time, U.S. Pipe's obligation to complete its response shall be tolled.
