ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION OF MCWANE, INC. FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On March 20, 2012, Respondent McWane, Inc. ("McWane") filed an unopposed motion to extend the time for McWane to file a response to SIP Industries' ("SIP") Motion to Quash McWane's Subpoena *Duces Tecum* ("Motion to Quash") served on it by SIP on or about March 9, 2012. McWane states that pursuant to the Federal Trade Commission Rules of Practice, 16 C.F.R. § 3.22(d), the deadline to file a response to the Motion to Quash was March 19, 2012. McWane seeks to extend its deadline to March 30, 2012.

In support of its motion, McWane states that the parties are engaged in negotiations regarding the scope of McWane's specifications, SIP's objections, and the time required for SIP to produce responsive documents and data. McWane further states that SIP does not oppose an extension and agrees that McWane should have an extension through March 30, 2012, to facilitate those negotiations and to file a response to SIP's Motion to Quash, should there remain any unresolved issues.

Accordingly, based on the foregoing, the Unopposed Motion is GRANTED. It is hereby ORDERED that the deadline for McWane to file any response to SIP's Motion to Quash shall be March 30, 2012.
