ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION OF CUSTOM FAB, INC. FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On April 16, 2012, non-party Custom Fab, Inc. ("Custom Fab") submitted an unopposed motion to extend the time for Custom Fab to move to limit or quash a Subpoena *Duces Tecum*, with a response date of April 22, 2012¹ and a Subpoena *Ad Testificandum*, with a response date of April 26, 2012 (collectively, the "Subpoenas") served on it by Respondent McWane, Inc. ("McWane") on April 2, 2012. Custom Fab seeks an order extending its deadline to May 26, 2012.

In support of its motion, Custom Fab asserts that the parties have entered negotiations regarding the scope of the Subpoena, its objections, and the time required for Custom Fab to produce its documents and data and to conduct depositions. Custom Fab further states that McWane does not oppose an extension of time in order to afford both parties' counsel sufficient time to continue to negotiate the limitations and modifications of McWane's request to reduce or limit the scope of Custom's Fab production, thereby potentially avoiding the necessity of filing a motion to quash or limit the Subpoenas.

Accordingly, based on the foregoing, the Unopposed Motion is GRANTED. It is hereby ORDERED that the deadline for non-party Custom Fab to file any motion to limit or quash the Subpoenas shall be May 25, 2012².
