Intel initially agreed to extend the time to file a motion to quash or limit the Subpoena until April 9, 2010.

Via and Intel are still in the process of negotiating in an attempt to resolve Via's concerns regarding the scope and burden of the Subpoena and other issues regarding the Subpoena. As part of these negotiations, on April 7, 2010, Intel just provided Via with a list of requested categories of documents in an attempt to narrow the Subpoena. Via and Intel have not had an opportunity to meet and confer regarding the new categories and so have not yet completed their negotiations.

Via and Intel have agreed to a second extension of time to file a motion to quash or limit the Subpoena to April 19, 2010. The extension is sought to allow for potential resolution of this discovery dispute without litigation. Counsel for Intel and the Federal Trade Commission do not oppose this extension.

Accordingly, Via requests that this motion be granted and that it be given until April 19, 2010 to file a motion to quash or limit the Subpoena, without prejudice to seek a further extension of this deadline.
