## FOURTH UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Non-party Hewlett-Packard Company ("HP") files this fourth motion to extend the time permitted for HP to move to limit the Subpoena *Duces Tecum* served on it by Complaint Counsel.

Complaint Counsel served HP with the Subpoena *Duces Tecum* on Monday, March 8, 2010. Under the applicable procedures of the Federal Trade Commission Rules of Practice, the time to file a Motion to Limit or Quash Complaint Counsel's Subpoena *Duces Tecum* was March 18, 2010. On March 18, 2010, HP filed an Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time in regards to the Federal Trade Commission Subpoena *Duces Tecum*, which was granted on March 19, 2010. The time in which HP may file a Motion to Limit or Quash Complaint Counsel's Subpoena *Duces Tecum* was extended through Monday, March 29, 2010. On March 26, 2010, HP filed a Second Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time, which was granted on March 29, 2010. On April 8, 2010, HP filed a Third Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time, which was granted on April 8, 2010.
