## FIFTH UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Non-party Hewlett-Packard Company ("HP") files this fifth motion to extend the time permitted for HP to move to limit the Subpoena *Duces Tecum* served on it by Intel Corporation ("Intel").

Intel served HP with the Subpoena *Duces Tecum* on Friday, March 19, 2010. Under the applicable procedures of the Federal Trade Commission Rules of Practice, the time to file a Motion to Limit or Quash Intel's Subpoena *Duces Tecum* is March 29, 2010.

Intel does not oppose to this fifth extension of time for HP to file a Motion to Limit or Quash the Subpoena *Duces Tecum* through May 10, 2010, while the parties try to reach agreement on the scope of the Subpoena *Duces Tecum*.
