SECOND UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE MOTION TO QUASH OR LIMIT SUBPOENA DUCES TECUM

Non-party GLOBALFOUNDRIES U.S. Inc. ("GLOBALFOUNDRIES") files this motion to extend the time permitted for GLOBALFOUNDRIES to move to quash or limit the Subpoena *Duces Tecum* served on it by Intel Corporation ("Intel").

Intel served GLOBALFOUNDRIES with the Subpoena *Duces Tecum* on Friday, April 15, 2010. On April 22, 2010, GLOBALFOUNDRIES filed an Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File Motion to Quash or Limit Subpoena *Duces Tecum* until May 17, 2010. This Court granted GLOBALFOUNDRIES' motion on April 23, 2010.

Intel has agreed to a further extension of time for GLOBALFOUNDRIES to respond to the Subpoena *Duces Tecum*. The parties are still in the process of negotiating in an attempt to resolve GLOBALFOUNDRIES' concerns regarding the scope of the Subpoena *Duces Tecum*, and have agreed to an extension of time to file a Motion to Quash or Limit the Subpoena *Duces Tecum* to May 28, 2010 in order to attempt to resolve these concerns without litigation. Counsel for Intel does not oppose this extension.

Accordingly, GLOBALFOUNDRIES requests that this Court grant it until May 28, 2010 to file a Motion to Quash or Limit the Subpoena *Duces Tecum*, and that GLOBALFOUNDRIES' obligation to otherwise respond to the Subpoena shall be tolled during that period.
