ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION OF NON-PARTY GLOBALFOUNDRIES U.S. INC. FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO MOVE TO LIMIT OR QUASH SUBPOENA DUCES TECUM

On May 13, 2010, non-party Globalfoundries U.S. Inc. ("Globalfoundries") submitted a Second Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to Move to Quash or Limit a Subpoena *Duces Tecum* served on it by Respondent Intel on April 15, 2010 ("Subpoena"). Pursuant to its unopposed motion submitted April 22, 2010, Globalfoundries received a previous extension of time through May 17, 2010. *See* Order Granting Globalfoundries' Motion for Extension of Time, April 23, 2010.

Globalfoundries states that Respondent has agreed to a further extension of time, through May 28, 2010, so that Globalfoundries and Respondent can continue their negotiations to resolve Globalfoundries' concerns regarding the scope of the Subpoena. Globalfoundries also requests that its obligation to otherwise respond to the Subpoena be tolled during the period of the extension.

Based on the foregoing, Globalfoundries' Second Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time is GRANTED, and it is hereby ORDERED that Globalfoundries shall have until May 28, 2010, to file a motion to quash or limit the subpoena served upon Globalfoundries by Respondent on April 15, 2010, and further, that Globalfoundries' obligation to otherwise respond to the Subpoena shall be tolled during the period of the extension.
