GPO MAKES U.S. CONSTITUTION AVAILABLE TO CONGRESS AND PUBLIC ON HISTORIC ANNIVERSARY

WASHINGTON—On this day in 1787 a historic event for our Nation took place in Philadelphia, PA. The United States is celebrating the 225th anniversary of the adoption of the *Constitution of the United States*. The U.S. Government Printing Office (GPO) makes the Constitution available to Congress and the public in a variety of formats. GPO produces the pocket version of the Constitution for Members of Congress to hand out to their constituents and also makes it available through GPO's retail and online bookstores. GPO produced more than 230,000 copies for Congress. The U.S. Constitution is available digitally on GPO's Federal Digital System (FDsys), a one-stop site to authentic, published Government information. Various libraries nationwide have the U.S. Constitution available for their communities as part of the Federal Depository Library Program (FDLP).

GPO is the Federal Government's primary resource for producing, procuring, cataloging, indexing, authenticating, disseminating, and preserving the official information products of the U.S. Government in both digital and tangible formats. GPO is responsible for the production and distribution of information products and services for all three branches of the Federal Government, including U.S. passports for the Department of State as well as the official publications of Congress, the White House, and other Federal agencies. In addition to publication sales, GPO provides for permanent public access to Federal Government information at no charge through GPO's Federal Digital System (www.fdsys.gov) and through partnerships with approximately 1,200 libraries nationwide participating in the Federal Depository Library Program.
