> RE: Comment suggesting exemption to proposed National Do Not Call Registry

Respectfully request that you incorporate in your rule establishing a National **"Do** Not Call" Registry one of the following three exemptions:

An exemption for anyone calling on behalf of a 501(c)(3),(4) or (19) organization and/or its Foundation recognized in its ByLaws.

or

2. An exemption for anyone calling on behalf of a Congressionally Chartered Veterans Organization andlor its Foundation recognized in its ByLaws.

3. An exemption for anyone calling to solicit donations of secondhand clothing and/or household goods.

One of the above exemptions is needed for the following reasons. The use of the telephone has provided the means whereby the Foundation is able to assist our less-fortunate veterans to obtain their justifiable benefits, entitlements, medical care, employment, education, nursing home care and or domiciliary accommodations.
