This database links over 11.000 consumer brands to health effects from Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) provided by manufacturers and allows consumers to research products based on chemical ingredients. The database is designed to help answer the following typical questions:

- What are the chemical ingredients ٠ and their percentage in specific brands?
- Which products contain specific • chemical ingredients?
- Who manufactures a specific ٠ brand? How do I contact this manufacturer?
- What are the acute and chronic ٠ effects of chemical ingredients in a specific brand?
- What other information is available • about chemicals in the toxicologyrelated databases of the National Library of Medicine?
