How to Read the Quality-Data Code Submission Error Report by Specialty:

Using the Specialty of Allergy/Immunologists as an example, we find the following information as we read across each column:

72,374 QDC submissions were received for measures reported by this specialty, 65,128 of which were considered valid. Therefore, the Valid Submission Rate is 89.99%. There were a total of 65,354 QDCs reported on eligible cases. The rest of the columns explain reasons for invalid submissions for measures reported by this specialty. We see that 3,679 (5.08%) submissions did not match the measure's age and/or gender parameters; 6,745 (9.32%) submissions were for patient encounters and/or diagnoses that are not listed in the denominator of the measures.

Oncology/Hematology (96.75%),

Nuclear Medicine (95.71%),

Cardiology (95.25%),

1. The specialties submitting valid QDC's on each measure are displayed. Two measures were reported by only one specialty: Measure #66 Appropriate
Testing for Children with Pharyngitis was reported on only by Emergency Medicine and Measure # 94 Otitis Media with Effusion(OME): Diagnostic Evaluation Assessment of Tympanic Membrane Mobility was reported on only by Otolaryngology.
