Rangeland Improvement Project System (RIPS)

Description of System:

The Rangeland Improvement Project System (RIPS) tracks range improvement funds collected by BLM from fees paid by those who graze their livestock on BLM land It also provides management data regarding range improvements such as spring developments, cattle guards, exclosures, and others The Federal Land Policy and Management Act of 1976 (43 USC 1701-1784) states that the funds are to be used for projects-such as fencing, weed control, and water development-that benefit rangeland resources, including wildlife, watersheds, and livestock In 1993, the General Accounting Office reported to congress that BLM's range improvement project database was incomplete and inaccurate, which lead to further development of the RIPS system to better record and track range improvement projects on BLM administered lands Instruction Memorandum (IM) 2001-27 established a policy that all projects must be entered into RIPS, excluding projects regarding facility asset management, abandoned mine lands, HazMat, natural resource damage assessment, and threatened and endangered species This policy also established the use of fee-for-service (FFS) codes to link RIPS projects to BLM financial systems
