	GENERAL DISPOSITION AUTHORITIES FOR OFFICE OF ORIGIN CASE FILES, October 16, 1995-Ongoing (2) Exceptional Case Files: These case files document the FBI's investigation of a significant individual, event or organization, or evidence of a precedent-setting program, or in some other way constitute a landmark case. The National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) as well as historians and other experts outside the Federal Government identified an initial list of Exceptional Case Files. In order to supplement this list, NARA developed five general criteria, which are applied to all case files in order to determine their eligibility for permanent retention. This request for disposition authority is being submitted to correct a typographical error, which was approved in a previous authority.
