H.R. 5882 – The Fiscal Year 2013 Legislative Branch Appropriations Bill

Floor Adopted Amendments

<u>Gosar (R-AZ)</u> – The amendment makes a \$1.2 million cut for the Architect of the Capitol to terminate the upkeep and maintenance of the National Botanical Garden, and transfers the funding to the spending reduction account. **The amendment was adopted on vote of 213-193.**

<u>Broun (R-GA)</u> – The amendment cuts the Congressional Research Service (CRS) salaries account by \$878,000, and transfers the funding to the spending reduction account. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 214-189.**

<u>Holt (D-NJ)</u> – The amendment makes a symbolic transfer of funds within the Government Printing Office (GPO). The intent of the amendment is to encourage GPO to provide multiple copies of pocket Constitutions to Members of Congress. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Scalise (R-LA)</u> – The amendment would terminate funding for the Open World Leadership Center Trust Fund (\$1 million), and transfer the funds to the spending reduction account. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 204-203.**

<u>Harper (R-MS)</u> – The amendment prohibits funding to provide more than 50 copies of U.S. Code to the House, including all member/committee/leadership offices. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**
