Discontinuation of Hard Copy Compliance Guidance

The Mine Safety and Health Administration (MSHA) spends over \$500,000 annually on printing and postage associated with hard copy mailing of compliance guidance (e.g. Program Policy Letters, Program Information Bulletins, and Procedure Instruction letters). Production cost continues to escalate and MSHA is exploring cost effective alternatives.

Therefore, effective October 01, 2012, MSHA is modifying its distribution practice and limiting mailings to individuals who express a desire to receive hard copies.
