Your kids will be covered on and off the field, long after the season ends. Signing up means your kids can get doctor and dentist visits, vision and hearing care, hospital care, mental health services, regular check-ups and shots and needed treatment, including prescription drugs.



Once signed up, your kids will receive the benefits of coverage for a year. When it's time to renew your child's coverage, a notice will come in the mail.
