Three Rivers, CA – Due to an impending winter storm warning, the road between Sequoia and Kings Canyon National Parks will be closed for this weekend. If significant snowfall occurs, then the road will be closed for the season through April 1, 2012. Tire chains or cables may be required at any time on open roads.
