Continuous Learning

Continuous learning augments education, training, and experience standards established for the Defense Acquisition Workforce. DoD Instruction 5000.66 establishes the standard that Defense Acquisition Workforce members must acquire 80 Continuous Learning Points (CLP) every two years from the date of entry into the acquisition workforce for as long as the member remains in an acquisition position. What is ACQTAS Continuous Learning (CL)?

The 4th Estate DACM has developed the ACQTAS for Continuous Learning (ACQTAS-CL) system that permits online requests and tracking of Continuous Learning Points (CLPs) for acquisition workforce members within the 4th Estate Community. By using this system, employees can submit credit requests for continuous learning events as well as keep track of the CLPs they have already earned.

How Do I Meet The CL Requirement?

Defense Acquisition Workforce members must demonstrate that they meet CLP requirements by obtaining the required 80 CLPs in the ACQTAS-CL system within two years.

- DAU training events including classroom training, online courses, and modules will automatically be credited with CLPs in the ACQTAS-CL system upon event completion.
- Employees can request CLPs for any non-DAU event by clicking on "Request Continuous Learning Points." After entering a request, it will be sent to the employee's supervisor for final approval.
- Once a continuous learning activity is approved, ACQTAS-CL will automatically update CLP totals and notify both the student and supervisor of the progress.
- When the required 80 CLPs are earned within two years, employees will receive a 4th Estate continuous learning certificate of achievement via email.
- Email reminders are automatically sent if an employee is not on track to meet the required 80 CLPs in two years.
