

### U.S. Exports: Regional Markets Comparison (2011)








### U.S. Exports: Regional Markets Comparison (2010)








### U.S. Exports: Priority Markets Comparison (2011)














#### **Trade Volume 2009-2011: A Snapshot**






- Total Trade 2009: \$10.756 billion; Total Trade 2010: \$14.752 billion
- Total Trade 2011 \$19.851 billion has broken all records for the full year.

\$1,536,794,033 (<u>256%</u>) increase





• Turkey is the 10<sup>th</sup> largest agricultural export market for the United States. (\$2.54 billion in CY 2011)






#### **Foreign Agricultural Service**



- The U.S. and Turkey are partners in agriculture, and U.S. exporters provide critical inputs for Turkey's food and fiber manufacturing and export industries.
- Turkey re-exports or adds value to over 85% of products it imports from the United States.

\$143,435,316 (<u>55%</u>) increase





### U.S. and Turkey FDI Inflows, 2008-2011 \$ Million USD




\*In 2011, the U.S. is the **fifth largest investor** of equity capital in Turkey

#### Cumulative FDI Flows: 2002-2011 (\$ Million)






### According to ISPAT, U.S. is third largest investor in Turkey on a historical basis




#### FDI Stocks\* as of 2010 (\$ Million)
