On April 15, 2009, the President identified Los Zetas as a Tier I drug kingpin pursuant to the Foreign Kingpin Narcotics Designation Act.

On June 1, 2001, the President identified Osiel CARDENAS GUILLEN a Tier I drug kingpin pursuant to the Foreign Narcotics Kingpin Designation Act.

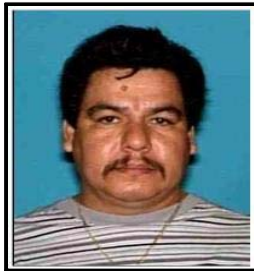
Key Los Zetas Fugitives
