Medical discount plans don't pay your health care costs. They're not insurance. They offer discounts from certain providers.

Many discount plans don't make good on their promises. Marketers may make it sound like discounts are bigger than they are, or like they're offering affordable health insurance. You learn the truth when you get a bill.

Many plans don't include local providers – or give you current lists. Before you enroll or pay any money, call local providers on the list and check whether they offer the advertised discounts.

Some offers are just plain scams. The plan you get could be worthless or a ploy to steal your information – and then your identity. Check out the company with your state Attorney General or state insurance department.
