## CMS 2010 Fee-for-Service (FFS) Medicare Enrollment

This supplement includes tables showing enrollment in Fee-for-Service (FFS) Medicare programs in calendar year 2010.

Table 1 provides the unduplicated number of beneficiaries enrolled in FFS Medicare in 2010 by gender, age categories, and total months of enrollment in FFS Medicare Part A and/or Part B. Table 1 includes beneficiaries who were enrolled in Fee-for-Service Medicare Part A and/or Part $B$ for at least one month in 2010. Examples of included beneficiaries are beneficiaries who i) turned 65 in 2010 and enrolled in traditional Medicare Part A and/or Part B, ii) enrolled in traditional Medicare Part A and/or Part B for part of 2010 and in Health Maintenance Organization (HMO), or Part C, plans in other months of 2010, and iii) enrolled in traditional Medicare Part A and/or Part B for part of 2010 but died later in 2010. It excludes beneficiaries who were enrolled only in HMO Plans in 2010.

Table 2 provides the unduplicated number of beneficiaries enrolled in Medicare Part D by gender, age categories, and total months of enrollment in Medicare Part D.
