State Cooperative Program Roles & Responsibilities (Text Version)

CFSAN, DFSR and ORA Regional Retail Food, Milk and Shellfish Specialists all work cooperatively with state and local personnel to implement state and local Retail Food, Milk and Shellfish Programs.

CFSAN is responsible for: developing and interpreting model codes, ordinances and other guidance documents; identifying research needs; conducting training and standardizing FDA Regional Specialists; and maintaining national listings of firms that meet program requirements.

DFSR is responsible for providing funding to support States in implementing model codes, ordinances, etc (e.g. training), serving as a resource to the Regional Specialists, and also works on building positive relationships between FDA and state programs.

ORA Regional Retail Food, Milk and Shellfish Specialists serve as the primary points of contact for states. They work with states to improve their programs through various means, such as: training and certifying state and local personnel; auditing state inspections; promoting the adoption of FDA's model codes and ordinances.
