## THIRD ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO FILE ANSWERS

On January 2, 2002, the parties filed a Joint Motion for Further Extension to Answer the Complaint. By Orders dated November 16, 2001 and December 6, 2001, two previous joint motions for extension were granted.

Section 3.51(a) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, 16 C.F.R. § 3.51(a), requires an initial decision to be filed by October 28, 2002. In the event the parties are not able to settle this matter, the discovery and trial schedule issued will meet the October 28, 2002 deadline.
