**ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINT COUNSEL'S MOTION  
TO PLACE THE UNREDACTED COMPLAINT ON THE PUBLIC RECORD**


On January 13, 2012, Complaint Counsel filed a Motion to Place the Unredacted Complaint on the Public Record ("Motion"). Complaint Counsel represents that Respondents Illinois Tool Works Inc. and ITW Finishing LLC (collectively "ITW") do not oppose disclosing the redacted material received from ITW, but that Respondent Graco Inc. ("Graco") does. Graco initially filed an Opposition to the Motion on January 23, 2012.

On January 26, 2012, Judge Robert L. Wilkins, U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia, granted a motion filed by the Federal Trade Commission to unseal a virtually identical version of this Complaint in the related district court proceeding before Judge Wilkins. On January 30, 2012, Graco filed a Withdrawal of Respondent Graco Inc.'s Memorandum of Law in Response to Complaint Counsel's Motion to Place the Unredacted Complaint on the Public Record ("Withdrawal"). In the Withdrawal, Graco states, "[i]n light of the ruling of the United States District Court for the District of Columbia, Respondent Graco Inc. will not continue to oppose the motion to place the unredacted complaint on the public record and hereby withdraws its Memorandum of Law in Response to Complaint Counsel's Motion to Place the Unredacted Complaint on the Public Record."

Accordingly, Complaint Counsel's Motion to Place the Unredacted Complaint on

the Public Record is hereby GRANTED.
