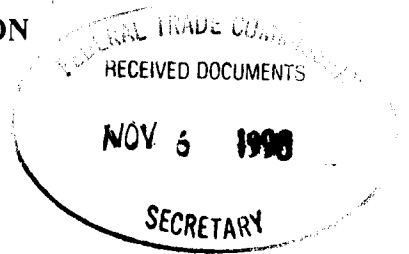

ORDER


WHEREAS, Non-Party Dell Computer Corporation ("Dell") has applied for permanent *in camera* treatment of Exhibit "C" to Intel Corporation's Motion to Compel Production of Complete Responses to Civil Investigative Demands (the "Motion"); and

WHEREAS, public disclosure of the confidential information contained in Exhibit "C" would likely result in a clearly defined, serious injury of indefinite duration to the third parties whose confidential information is at issue; and

WHEREAS, Dell's application for permanent *in camera* treatment is unopposed:

NOW THEREFORE, I find that permanent *in camera* treatment is warranted and order that Dell's application is hereby GRANTED.

The Secretary shall permanently maintain Exhibit "C" to the Motion under seal. A public version of the Motion, without the attached Exhibit "C," shall be placed on the public record.
