ORDER ON ELAN PHARMACEUTICALS, INC.'S MOTION TO QUASH

Respondent Andrx Corporation ("Andrx"), served a third party subpoena duces tecum and ad testificandum on Elan Pharmaceuticals, Inc. ("Elan, Inc.") seeking the production of documents and the designation of a company representative to testify regarding those documents. On September 11, 2000, Elan, Inc. filed a motion to quash the subpoenas served on it by Andrx.
