Corporation ("First Health") respectfully submits this Motion For Extension of Time to Oppose

Respondents Evanston Northwestern Healthcare's and ENH Medical Group's Motion to Compel

First Health to Produce Documents Requested by Subpoenas Duces Tecum. This motion is

based on the grounds set forth in the attached supporting memorandum.

First Health and Respondents have engaged in numerous conversations since the motion to compel was served on First Health. Both First Health and Respondents believe that all disputes can be worked out and that it is in the interest of all relevant parties for First Health and Respondents to continue to work through the requests in the subpoena, rather than engage in protracted litigation regarding the motion to compel. First Health respectfully submits that a short extension of time to resolve all outstanding disputes arising under the subpoena will benefit all concerned in this litigation. Undersigned counsel has also been in contact with Federal Trade Commission ("FTC") attorneys and the FTC takes no position with respect to this motion for extension of time.

Accordingly, First Health respectfully petitions this Court for an Order extending the deadline for First Health's Opposition to the Motion to Compel until October 1, 2004. A proposed order is attached for the benefit of the Court.
