RESPONDENTS' MOTION TO COMPEL DOCUMENT PRODUCTION

Respondents Laboratory Corporation of America and Laboratory Corporation of America Holdings (collectively, "LabCorp"), pursuant to 16 C.F.R. §§ 3.37(b), 3.38A, and 3.38(a), respectfully move to compel Complaint Counsel to produce all documents responsive to Respondents' First Request for Production of Documents. Complaint Counsel has withheld documents based on the government deliberative process privilege, the attorney work-product doctrine, and the government informant privilege. Complaint Counsel has improperly invoked these privileges and must produce the withheld documents. Moreover, Complaint Counsel has not produced responsive communications with the Commission and has not included them on its privilege logs. It should be required to one or the other.

BACKGROUND

On December 17, 2010, Respondents served their First Request for Documents on the Federal Trade Commission, attached as Exhibit A (the "Document Requests"). On January 18, 2011, Complaint Counsel served Objections and Responses to the Document Requests

(“Objections and Responses”), attached as Exhibit B. Complaint Counsel also served Plaintiff’s First Privilege Log, attached as Exhibit C.¹

In its First Privilege Log, Complaint Counsel asserted the government deliberative process privilege and the attorney work-product doctrine for every document. Complaint Counsel also asserted the government informant privilege with respect to certain documents. While the First Privilege Log included a “Description” column that purported to describe the nature of the documents, the description was nearly identical for every document. Indeed, the only differences in the descriptions were the names of the senders and recipients and whether the document was an e-mail or an attachment – every description described the document as “regarding investigation of LabCorp’s purchase of Westcliff.”

Because the First Privilege Log failed to provide an adequate basis on which Respondents could assess the privilege claims and because it did not include internal FTC communications, Respondents conferred with Complaint Counsel via telephone on January 14, 2011. On that call, Complaint Counsel explained that all entries on the log pertain to communications with third parties. Complaint Counsel also confirmed that it had not produced or logged communications within the FTC, including communications between the FTC Staff and Commissioners. Respondents, in turn, questioned Complaint Counsel’s various privilege claims and requested a revised privilege log adequate to assess the basis of the privileges asserted. Respondents also requested that Complaint Counsel either produce communications between FTC staff and the Commission/Commissioners or produce a log of those

¹ On December 17, 2010, Respondents also served the FTC with Defendants’ First Request for Documents in the related preliminary injunction action pending in the United States District Court for the Central District of California, Case No. SACV10-1873 (AG) (MLGx) (the “Preliminary Injunction Action”). The parties have agreed that discovery obtained in the Preliminary Injunction Action could be used in the instant proceeding, and vice versa. Accordingly, Respondents understand that Complaint Counsel’s privilege logs apply to both the First Request for Production in the Preliminary Injunction Action as well as the Part III First Request, which covered substantially the same documents.

communications if Complaint Counsel believed that they were privileged. Complaint Counsel and Respondent could not reach agreement, but Complaint Counsel indicated that it would consider amending its First Privilege Log.

On January 18, 2011, Complaint Counsel served an Amended First Privilege Log, attached hereto as Exhibit D. The Amended Privilege Log still did not provide enough information upon which Respondents could assess the privilege claims. Complaint Counsel also served Respondents with Plaintiff's Supplemental Privilege Log, attached hereto as Exhibit E. The Supplemental Privilege Log lists sets of communications between the FTC and third-parties (including an individual represented by Respondents' Counsel). On or about January 25, 2011, Respondents discussed their continued concerns regarding the privilege logs and also noted that Complaint Counsel failed to provide an affidavit. Complaint Counsel indicated that it would assess whether it had such an obligation and respond accordingly. Respondents again followed up on February 7 and 8, 2011 and were informed that an affidavit was pending. As of this filing, Respondents have not received that affidavit, and the parties have reached an impasse.

ARGUMENT

I. Complaint Counsel Should be Compelled to Produce Documents Withheld on the Basis of the Government Deliberative Process Privilege

A. Complaint Counsel waived the privilege by failing to properly invoke it

Complaint Counsel failed to properly assert the government deliberative process privilege by not providing Respondents with an affidavit from an FTC Commissioner or another high-ranking agency official with delegated authority to invoke the privilege. This failure alone waives the privilege. *See L.H. v. Schwarzenegger*, 2008 WL 2073958, *7-8 (E.D. Cal. May 14, 2008) (holding that the agency waived the privilege and noting that “an explanation why [the document] properly falls within the scope of the privilege” is of “critical importance”).

The agency head or high-ranking official with delegated authority must personally review the documents for which the privilege is asserted. *Landry v. Fed. Deposit Ins. Corp.*, 204 F.3d 1125, 1135 (D.C. Cir. 2000); *In re Union Oil Co. of California*, 2003 FTC WL 21642422 (June 30, 2003) (citing *Landry* and holding that the privilege does not apply where it was not properly asserted). The procedural requirements are designed to “ensure that the privileges are presented in a deliberate, considered, and reasonably specific manner.” *Landry*, 204 F.3d at 1135 (citations omitted). Courts “have not permitted staff attorneys, especially those who are participating in the pending litigation, to assert the privilege on behalf of the agency.” *United States v. Rozet*, 183 F.R.D. 662, 665 (N.D. Cal. 1998).

B. The privilege does not apply to the documents at issue

Not only has Complaint Counsel waived the privilege by failing to properly invoke it, but, judging by the information Respondents can glean from the privilege log, Complaint Counsel’s assertions of the privilege appear unjustified.²

The deliberative process privilege only applies to documents that are both deliberative and pre-decisional. *See, e.g., Hongsermeier v. C.I.R.*, 621 F.3d 890, 904 (9th Cir. 2010). The burden is on the government to establish “what deliberative process is involved, and the role played by the documents in issue in the course of that process.” *Coastal States Gas Corp. v. Dep’t of Energy*, 617 F.2d 854, 868 (D.C. Cir. 1980). Complaint Counsel has failed to establish that the withheld documents are pre-decisional and has not even indicated to which Agency decision(s) the documents supposedly pertain. *Maricopa Audubon Soc’y v. U.S. Forest Serv.*, 108 F.3d 1089, 1094 (9th Cir. 1997).

² Commission Rule 3.38A requires Complaint Counsel to provide a privilege log that “will enable other parties to assess the claim.” Complaint Counsel’s privilege logs fall far short of this standard in many respects, but Respondents have attempted to assess Complaint Counsel’s claims given the information available and the discussions between counsel for Respondents and Complaint Counsel regarding the logs.

The Amended Privilege Log indicates that nearly all – if not all³ – of the supposedly privileged communications are between the FTC and the California Department of Justice.⁴ This is improper. A non-federal governmental agency is only within the privilege if it is advising the federal agency as though it is an unbiased consultant. *See People for the Am. Way Found. v. U.S. Dep’t of Educ.*, 516 F. Supp. 2d 28, 37 (D.D.C. 2007) (holding that a non-federal agency can be considered under the “consultant corollary” of the privilege, but it must be in an advisory position and not share responsibility and authority with the federal agency). A consultant cannot “represent an interest of its own, or the interest of any other client, when it advises the agency that hires it.” *Dep’t of the Interior v. Klamath Water Users Protective Ass’n*, 532 U.S. 1, 11 (2001).

The California Department of Justice is far from an unbiased consultant. The Office of the California Attorney General – part of the California Department of Justice – has brought a *qui tam* lawsuit against Respondents alleging that capitated rates for laboratory testing services are *too low*. By contrast, the FTC’s premise in the instant case is that Respondents’ merger with Westcliff will lead to *higher* capitated rates. The FTC apparently seeks the opposite of the result that the California Attorney General’s lawsuit attempts to achieve. Moreover, the California Attorney General investigated the LabCorp/Westcliff transaction and apparently declined to pursue an enforcement action, notwithstanding the FTC’s decision to challenge the merger. Therefore, the privilege cannot apply to communications between the FTC and the California Attorney General – a non-federal agency whose interests are at odds with the FTC. This defeats the alleged privilege for all documents involving the California Attorney General.

³ The Amended Privilege Log includes entries for voice messages that lack sufficient information for Respondents to decipher who are the parties to those communications. *See, e.g.*, Ex. C at 1, 25.

⁴ For example, the sixth entry of the Amended Privilege Log is from Winston Chen (Winston.Chen@doj.ca.gov) to Matthew Teich (mteich@ftc.gov). Ex. C at 1.

With respect to the Supplemental Privilege Log, the FTC claims that communications between its staff and non-governmental third parties – Emmett Kane and Danny Shoemaker – are also privileged. Mr. Shoemaker is the Interim Manager of Westcliff and, in that capacity, is represented by Hogan Lovells US LLP. Mr. Kane is the *independent* Monitor pursuant to the Hold Separate Agreement and is represented by his own attorney. Regardless of who represents these individuals, they are independent of the FTC and the government deliberative process privilege clearly does not apply.

Moreover, the government deliberative process privilege is a qualified one and does not apply if the “need for the materials and the need for accurate fact-finding override the government’s interest in non-disclosure.” *FTC v. Warner Commc’ns, Inc.*, 742 F.2d 1156, 1161 (9th Cir. 1984). The factors to balance these interests are: 1) the relevance of the evidence; 2) the availability of other evidence; 3) the government’s role in the litigation; and 4) the extent to which disclosure would hinder frank and independent discussion regarding contemplated policies and decisions. *Id.* The documents at issue here are highly relevant because the California Attorney General’s Office conducted its own investigation into this transaction and apparently chose not to pursue litigation. Moreover, the California Attorney General’s office is actively pursuing a case against Respondents and other providers of clinical laboratory services with a goal that appears to be at odds with the FTC’s current case. To that end, communications between the FTC and the California Attorney General’s Office are relevant and unique to the FTC’s files. The FTC would clearly be required to produce these documents if it was a private party, and allowing the FTC to evade discovery of them simply because it is a federal agency would be “fundamentally unfair.” *F.D.I.C. v. Hatziyannis*, 180 F.R.D. 292, 293 (D. Md. 1998).

Finally, the FTC has made no claim that disclosing these communications would hinder frank discussions in any way – nor would such a claim be valid.

Complaint Counsel has failed to meet its burden in asserting the government deliberative process privilege to all withheld documents, and those documents should therefore be produced.

II. The Attorney Work-Product Doctrine Does Not Apply

The attorney work-product doctrine does not save Complaint Counsel’s privilege claims. The work-product doctrine does not apply to e-mails from an attorney to a third-party witness where the third party does not share a common interest with the party of the disclosing attorney.

Ricoh Co. Ltd. v. Aeroflex Inc., 219 F.R.D. 66, 70 (S.D.N.Y. 2003) (finding waiver of work-product protection over e-mails defense counsel sent to an “independent” third-party “in furtherance of an investigation of an affirmative defense”). Regarding communications with the Office of the California Attorney General, the FTC does not share a common interest with that Office, which has a case whose fundamental goals are at odds with that of the FTC. Regarding communications with Mr. Kane and Mr. Shoemaker, the FTC waived any protection it might have had in certain information by disclosing that information to Messrs. Shoemaker and Kane, who are independent and do not share a common interest with the FTC. The withheld documents are therefore not protected by the work-product doctrine.

Even if the work-product doctrine did somehow apply to the documents at issue, that protection can be overcome by a showing that there is a substantial need for the materials in the preparation of the case and that the material cannot be obtained without undue hardship. 16 C.F.R. § 3.31(c)(5). Here, the communications between the FTC and the Office of the California Attorney General could contain exculpatory evidence that is particularly relevant to this case. The California Attorney General considered whether to bring a lawsuit of its own against

Respondents to challenge the acquisition of Westcliff, but it chose *not* to do so. Thus, the Office of the Attorney General has information that is highly relevant to Respondents' case and that it shared with the FTC. The FTC should not be able to claim such documents are protected work-product in light of Respondents' substantial need for the information.

III. The Government Informant Privilege Does Not Apply Once the Informer Has Been Disclosed

Complaint Counsel's assertion of the government informant privilege is also wholly without merit. The government has a limited privilege to withhold an informant's identity. Once the identity of the informer has been disclosed, the privilege no longer applies. *Roviaro v. United States*, 353 U.S. 53, 60 (1957); *see also In re MSC.Software Corp.*, 2002 FTC WL 31433972 (May 7, 2002) (Chappell, J.).

In the January 14, 2011 telephone conference with Respondents, Complaint Counsel represented that the withheld documents included the identity of informants whose names have already been disclosed to Respondents. Because the names of the government's "informants" have all been disclosed, there is no basis whatsoever for the government informant privilege.

IV. Complaint Counsel Must Produce or Log Communications with the Commission

Complaint Counsel, as a party to the litigation, is required by Commission Rule 3.38A to submit a detailed log of the items withheld from Complaint Counsel's files. *In re MSC.Software Corp.*, 2002 FTC WL 31433929 (Feb. 21, 2002) (Chappel, J.). Respondents' Document Requests seek documents within Complaint Counsel's files, including communications with the Commission, yet Complaint Counsel has withheld those documents and has not included them on its privilege logs. Under Rule 3.31, "[C]omplaint counsel is [not] required to search for materials generated and transmitted between . . . complaint counsel and non-testifying Commission employees . . ." Communications between FTC Staff and the

Commission/Commissioners are not, however, exempted. *See In re Inova Health System Found.*, 2008 FTC WL 2307161 (May 29, 2008) (statement of Commissioner Rosch) (concluding that the Administrative Procedures Act differentiates between Commission “employees” and Commissioners); *see also Tax Analysts v. I.R.S.*, 117 F.3d 607, 618 (D.C. Cir. 1997) (“In the governmental context, the ‘client’ may be the agency and the attorney may be an agency lawyer.”). As such, Respondents request that the Court compel Complaint Counsel to produce all such responsive documents in its files or, in the alternative, provide a privilege log including each such document.

CONCLUSION

For the reasons set forth herein, Respondents respectfully request that the Court grant Respondents’ Motion to Compel.


CERTIFICATE OF CONFERENCE

Respondents conferred with Complaint Counsel in an effort in good faith to resolve by agreement the issues raised by Respondents' Motion to Compel Document Production. On January 14, 2011, counsel for Respondents held a telephone conference with Complaint Counsel in which the parties discussed the issues at length. Respondents and Complaint Counsel were unable to reach agreement on the veracity of the privilege claims and on whether the FTC must produce – or include in its privilege log – documents within the FTC, including communications with the Commission. Although Complaint Counsel agreed to provide an amended privilege log, that log was still insufficient.

On or about January 25, 2011, Respondents discussed their continued concerns regarding the privilege logs with Complaint Counsel and also noted that Complaint Counsel had failed to provide an affidavit. Respondents held two more telephone conferences with Complaint Counsel – on February 7 and February 8, 2011 – to further resolve the disputed issues. Despite those repeated attempts, Respondents' and Complaint Counsel were unable to resolve the issues raised by this motion.



**RESPONDENTS' FIRST REQUEST FOR DOCUMENTS TO
FEDERAL TRADE COMMISSION**

Respondents Laboratory Corporation of America and Laboratory Corporation of America Holdings (collectively, "LabCorp"), by their undersigned attorneys, Hogan Lovells US LLP, hereby demand that, on or before January 17, 2011, the Federal Trade Commission ("FTC") produce all documents described below at the offices of Hogan Lovells US LLP (Attn: Benjamin F. Holt), Columbia Square, 555 Thirteenth Street, NW, Washington, DC, 20004. This demand is made pursuant to FTC Rule of Practice §§ 3.31, 3.34, and 3.37.

DOCUMENT REQUESTS

1. All Documents, from any time period, identified in the FTC's initial disclosures made pursuant to FTC Rule of Practice § 3.31(b).

DEFINITIONS

1. "All" and "each," as used herein, shall be construed as all and each.
2. "Any," as used herein, means each and every.
3. "Concerning" and "related to," as used herein, mean analyzing, alluding to, concerning, considering, commenting on, constituting, comprising, containing, describing,

dealing with, evidencing, identifying, involving, reporting on, relating to, reflecting, referring to, regarding, studying, mentioning, or pertaining to, in whole or in part.

4. "Document" is used in the broadest sense and includes, but is not limited to, all writings, drawings, graphs, charts, spreadsheets, sound and video recordings, electronic data, or data compilations, and any other materials described in FTC Rule of Practice §§ 3.34(b) and 3.31(c)(1), whether printed, recorded, produced, stored, or reproduced by any mechanical or electronic process, or written or produced by hand. This also includes, but is not limited to, any information contained in any computer, database, or word processing system, whether or not yet printed out, within the possession, custody, or control of the FTC. A draft or non-identical copy (including one with notations) is a separate document within the meaning of this term.

5. The "FTC," "You," and "Your," as used herein, means the United States Federal Trade Commission and its bureaus, offices, predecessors, successors, and assignees, its present and former Commissioners, officers, employees, agents, servants, representatives, consultants, accountants, economists, and lawyers, and all other persons who are acting or have acted on behalf of, or who are or have been subject to the direction or control of, any of the foregoing.

6. "LabCorp," as used herein, means Laboratory Corporation of America Holdings and its domestic or foreign parents, subsidiaries, divisions, affiliates, partnerships, joint ventures, and businesses, wherever located, including but not limited to LabWest, Inc., LabCorp's West Division, National Genetics Institute ("NGI"), Esoterix, and US LABS.

7. "Person," as used herein, means any natural person or any business, legal, or governmental entity or association.

8. "Respondents," as used herein, means LabCorp.

9. Any capitalized terms used but not defined herein shall have the same meaning assigned to them in the Complaint.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Furnish all responsive Documents in the possession, custody, or control of the FTC or in the possession, custody, or control of the FTC's representatives and agents.

2. These document requests are continuing in nature. Under FTC Rule of Practice § 3.31(e), You are required to supplement Your responses and produce additional Documents if You obtains further or different information, and LabCorp specifically reserves the right to seek supplementary responses and the additional supplementary production of Documents before the preliminary injunction hearing or before trial.

3. Provide all electronically stored information ("ESI") and hard copy Documents in standard, single-page Group IV TIFF format with accompanying extracted text and metadata in a Concordance load file. Provide Microsoft Access, Excel, and PowerPoint files, as well as audio, audiovisual, and video files, in their native formats. Produce the metadata for any responsive ESI with the responsive data, including the following fields: custodian, author(s), recipient(s), blind copy recipient(s), subject, file sent date/time, file creation date/time, file modification date/time, file last accessed date/time, beginning bates, ending bates, parent beginning bates, attachment(s) beginning bates, hash value, application type, file type, file name, file size, file path, and folder path. Documents produced in native format shall be accompanied by a native link field.

4. Where a claim of privilege is asserted in objecting to any request or sub-part thereof, and any document is withheld (in whole or in part) on the basis of such assertion, You shall provide a log ("Privilege Log") in Excel format that identifies:

- (a) the nature of the privilege (including attorney-client or work product) that is being claimed with respect to each document;
- (b) the type of each document;
- (c) the date of each document;
- (d) the custodian of the document;
- (e) the author of each document;
- (f) any addressees and recipients of each document (including those recipients cc-ed or bcc-ed);
- (g) a description of each document containing sufficient information to identify the general subject matter of the document and to enable LabCorp and the Court to assess the applicability of the privilege claimed, in accordance with Fed. R. Civ. P. 26; and
- (h) the identity of any attachment(s), enclosure(s), cover letter(s), or cover email(s) of each document.

Attachments, enclosures, cover letters, and cover emails shall be entered separately on the Privilege Log. The Privilege Log shall include the full name, title, and employer of each author, addressee, and recipient, denoting each attorney with an asterisk. Submit all non-privileged portions of any responsive document (including non-privileged or redactable attachments, enclosures, cover letters, and cover emails) for which a claim of privilege is asserted, noting where redactions to the document have been made.

5. If the FTC at any time had possession, custody, or control of a document responsive to these requests and if such document, or portion of such document, has been lost, destroyed, purged, or otherwise is not presently in the FTC's possession, custody, or control,

then: (a) identify the authors, addressees, recipients, date, subject matter, and type of document; (b) state the date of its loss, destruction, purge, or separation from the FTC's possession or control; (c) state the circumstances surrounding its loss, destruction, purge, or separation from the FTC's possession or control; and (d) state its present or last known location, including the name, address, and telephone number of each person believed to have possession of such document.



The full text of Respondents' Request is set forth below, single-spaced and in italics, followed by objections and the response.

Document Request 1:

All Documents, from any time period, identified in the FTC's initial disclosures made pursuant to FTC Rule of Practice § 3.31(b).

This response is made solely for the purposes of this action. This response does not waive or limit the FTC's right to object on grounds of competency, relevance, materiality, privilege, admissibility as evidence for any purposes, or any and all grounds to the use of any documents or information in any subsequent proceeding in, or trial of, this or any other action.

The FTC hereby reserves the right to raise and rely upon such other and further objections as may become apparent during the course of responding to discovery.

The FTC objects to this Request to the extent it expressly or impliedly seeks information protected from discovery by the attorney-client privilege, the attorney work product doctrine, self evaluative privilege, audit privilege, government deliberative process privilege, government informant privilege or other privileges or reasons for non-production. Documents and information covered by such privileges are not subject to disclosure. Inadvertent disclosure of privileged information is not intended to be, and may not be construed as, a waiver of any applicable privilege. These objections include but are not limited to the following:

- a. On the basis of the work product doctrine and attorney-client privilege, the FTC objects to this Request to the extent it calls for the production of notes, data compilations or summaries, internal communications, internal forms, or memoranda of FTC attorneys and staff or correspondence and documents exchanged between the FTC and its agents or non-testifying experts;
- b. On the basis of the work product doctrine, attorney-client privilege, and government deliberative process privilege, the FTC objects to this Request to the extent it calls for the production of any communications, memoranda, or documents between FTC attorneys or staff or between FTC attorneys or staff and FTC Commissioners or their staff;
- c. On the basis of government informant privilege, the FTC objects to this Request to the extent it calls for the production of complaints or documents received from confidential government informants or documents that necessarily would identify the informants.

The FTC objects to this Request to the extent it expressly or impliedly seeks proprietary, confidential, financial, trade secret or commercially sensitive information from third parties that could harm third parties' competitive or business positions or result in a breach of the FTC's obligation to maintain the confidentiality of such information. Any confidential or proprietary information will be produced pursuant to the Protective Order agreed to by the parties in this matter dated December 1, 2010, the Order of ALJ Chappell dated December 1, 2010, and the Order Granting Joint Motion for a Stipulated Protective Order in the federal action dated January 4, 2011.

The FTC objects to the definitions of the "FTC," "You," and "Your" as overbroad and unduly burdensome to the extent they include parties other than the FTC or its employees.

The FTC reserves the right to redact all irrelevant, privileged, or otherwise protected material in the documents that it produces in this action.

The FTC objects to this Request to the extent responsive information is contained in or can be derived from Defendants' own documents and data and the burden and expense of deriving or ascertaining such information is substantially the same for Defendants as it is for the FTC.

Subject to and without waiving these objections, the FTC has produced all responsive, non-privileged documents that are identified in the FTC's initial disclosures made pursuant to
