The following inquiry has been received: "1. The RFP states that the DCC will receive data from the TC, CC, RC. Will all of this data be in an electronic format?"

The following response applies: The data collection process is addressed in the Statement of Work (Article C.1.), Phase I, item numbers 5-8. Also see Descriptions & Statement of Work paragraph d. Offerors Must Address numbers 6 & 8.

The following inquiry has been received: "If so, will the DCC be involved in creating the systems to collect and/or enter data?"

The following response applies: See Statement of Work (Article C.1) and Evaluation Criteria/Method of Review (Section M). For example, see Statement of Work (Article C.1) numbers 7 and 8. This is also addressed in Section M-Evaluation Criteria/Method of Review, criterion numbers 1 and 2.
