- Implementation Procedures Guide (IA RX Fire Guide) was issued by the 6
- National Wildland Fire Coordinating Group (NWCG) on August 6, 2008. The 7
- IA RX Fire guide provides consistent interagency policy, establishes common 8
- terms and definitions, and identifies planning and implementation processes for 9
- prescribed fire. These procedures meet all policy requirements described in the 10
- 2003 Interagency Strategy for the Implementation of Federal Wildland Fire 11

- fire planning and implementation. Agencies may choose to provide more 16
- restrictive standards and policy direction, but must adhere to these minimums. 17
